

## IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Anti freeze in toilets and traps, etc. is only effective to minus 10 degrees. Temperatures in excess of minus 15 degrees have been experienced in previous years throughout the night and day.

All toilets will be sealed and must remain sealed until the drain up date. The van will be ready for you to use on the date that the drain up is requested but the water will be switched off at the stop tap. If you are not sure where your stop tap is, please let us know.

Please remember that at the beginning of the season it is possible, due to extreme weather conditions, for water to vans to be frozen in the ground. If this should be the case at the beginning of next season, your van would not be drained up for obvious reasons.

If you use your van early in the season but do not wish to stay overnight, we strongly recommend that the van is left drained down. This means that you should obtain water from the public taps and use whichever public toilet block is available.
